

#### **1 – Adnan Bali (Member of the Board and Chief Executive Officer)**

Born in İslahiye in 1962, Adnan Bali graduated from Department of Economics of Faculty of Administrative Sciences, Middle East Technical University. He started his professional career at İşbank as an Assistant Inspector on the Board of Inspectors in 1986. In 1994, he was promoted to the post of Assistant Manager at Treasury Department where he became Group Manager in 1997 and Manager in 1998. Adnan Bali became Manager of Şişli and Galata Branches in 2002 and 2004, respectively. He was appointed as Deputy Chief Executive on 30 May 2006 and as the Chief Executive Officer on 1 April 2011.
